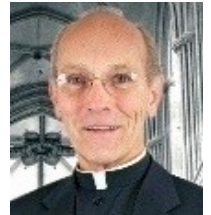

### **About Our Temporary Administrator**

Monsignor James E. Wall, who much prefers to be called simply, Father Jim, has been a priest of the Diocese of Buffalo for 53 years. He served in Puerto Rico and in Bolivia, South America as a member of the first missionary band from the diocese. Upon his return he served in various parishes as parochial vicar.



His first assignment as pastor was to St. Joseph Parish in Fredonia. He was then assigned as pastor to SS. Peter and Paul Parish in Jamestown. After that he was appointed Director of the St. Columban Retreat Center in Derby. He spent 17 years in that position and while he was there he was also named Vicar for Priests for the Diocese and Co-Director of the Continuing Formation Committee for Priests.

Father retired in 2012, but has taken a number of temporary assignments as administrator of parishes since then. He continues to do spiritual direction for priests, deacons, deacon candidates, seminarians and laity at Christ the King Seminary where he resides.

He is happy to be temporary administrator here at St. George's until a pastoral administrator is named. He will then continue to be with us as sacramental minister celebrating Masses, weddings, funerals and hearing confessions and celebrating the sacrament of the sick to those in need.

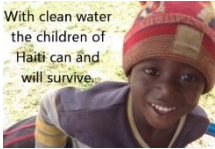

Dear Parishioners of St. George Parish,

I wish to inform you that after consulting with the diocesan boards for priest personnel and pastoral administrators, as well as the Presbyteral Council, I have decided to appoint a new leadership team to St. George Parish. This team will include a pastoral administrator, a sacramental minister and a priest moderator. This new approach to parish leadership has already been exercised with great success in hundreds of parishes around the country, and several parishes within this diocese. This leadership model is most effective and will only be implemented in vital parishes within this diocese. I made this decision for St. George Parish after receiving input from the May 24th meeting of your parishioners with the visitation team.

Pending my imminent appointment of a pastoral administrator, I have appointed Msgr. James Wall to serve as temporary administrator of the parish, effective June 1, 2016. Once I have appointed a pastoral administrator, Msgr. Wall will continue to serve as a sacramental minister with support from other priests on the faculty of Christ the King Seminary. I expect this new leadership team to be in place by the end of summer.

I have accepted the request for retirement from Rev. Pascal Ipolito, effective May 31, 2016. I wish to express my sincere gratitude to Fr. Ipolito for his eight years of leadership at St. George Parish and I wish him the very best as he transitions to a new phase of priestly life and ministry within our diocese.

Be assured of my gratitude and my prayers for God's blessing on your community and its mission to share the joy of the Gospel in the years ahead!
