Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

A retreat master once proclaimed that the little we do is infinitely more than doing nothing! That's a comforting thought, isn't it? We can often be overwhelmed with news of the many ills, near and far, that befall people. Our hearts are moved with compassion and we wonder what we can do to be of help, while knowing that so many situations are way beyond our ability to affect.
