Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

A great gift in our Roman Catholic Tradition is the celebration of Sacraments.



*Derived from Gospel events, these seven rites have evolved through the centuries and offer us profound insight into the reality of God. One way to define “sacrament” is to break the word into its root parts—“sacra” / “ment”: **sacra**, as in sacred or holy, and **ment**, as in moment or bit of time. Sacraments are holy times; they present us with sacred moments!*

It is part of our limitation as humans that we cannot hold on to the reality that God is always and everywhere present, active and loving. A very wise retreat master once shared that “out of God we cannot fall”. This is not meant to be a clever, Zen master type saying, but a mind expanding reminder that all that we are, have, do and say is surrounded by God! It is too much for us to maintain and keep in our awareness at all times. We may forget about God but, thankfully, God never forgets about us.

This takes us back to the gift that sacraments are for Roman Catholics. These holy moments have been ritualized so that God, breaking into our human existence, might be more clearly seen, understood and experienced. Cleansing waters are poured over us, rich oils anoint us, we taste bread and wine, we inhale sweet perfumes, we hear consoling words. In each sacrament our Church invites us to encounter God. Jesus, as Lord and mediator, has shown us these pathways and continually invites us to closer union in the Spirit.
