The Second Sunday of Advent

Many of our parishioners over the age of 60 probably had the experience of religious sisters or brothers teaching them, either in school or in faith formation (known as CCD in olden days). Those under 60 years of age, and especially anyone under the age of 30, probably have not had a religious as a teacher and many have never really known one. Few media images of those in religious life have given realistic images of sisters or brothers in our culture today. I can think of only one: Susan Sarandon portrayed Sister Helen Prejean in the movie *Dead Man Walking*, and the few scenes of her interacting with her community of sisters rang true to me.

Next weekend you will find an envelope among your weekly offering envelopes for the annual *Retirement Fund for Religious*. Religious communities care for themselves financially based on the income of those gainfully employed. As our members have aged out of the active employment market, our pool of resource money has dwindled. My community, the *Sisters of St. Mary of Namur*, relies on grants from the national Retirement Fund for Religious, as do most of the local communities of men and women religious. I am grateful for my salary here at St. George, which goes directly to my community's common bank account to help cover living costs for the 65 or so sisters in our Province. Check out our Jesse Tree in the gathering space! This Catholic tradition helps us connect the custom of decorating Christmas trees to the story of our salvation. The Jesse Tree is named from today's first reading from Isaiah: "On that day, a shoot shall sprout from the stump of Jesse, and from his roots, a bud shall blossom." Jesse was the father of King David.

Each day of Advent, we adorn the Jesse Tree with illustrated ornaments that represent the people, prophecies, and events in the Old Testament that lead up to the birth of our savior, Jesus. They show God's faithfulness across 4,000 years of history!
