Palm/Passion Sunday

As a member of an international religious congregation, the Sisters of St. Mary of Namur, I have had the opportunity to travel to several foreign mission areas and experience life in vastly different cultures. In the year 2000, I spent five months in the Democratic Republic of Congo. These months included the Lenten and Easter Seasons. In an area without highways, electricity or running water, the pace of life is MUCH slower. Daily efforts are focused on providing the basics of life. Sunday church attendance is a highlight activity of the week!

When the Sunday worship marks a special celebration such as today's, energy and creativity seem to burst into every aspect of the mass. A benefit of life in a rainforest is an unending supply of wild flowers and foliage. For Palm Sunday processions (which can be miles in length), people literally take branches and flowers from their surroundings and braid them together to wave as they walk. Once in the church building, as people take their places, dozens of women cover the main aisle of the church floor with their shoulder wraps. After the priest enters, having walked along this pathway of garments, the women retrieve their wraps feeling blessed that they helped provide a joyous welcome to the presider and through him to the Lord!

Our society offers so many options for our attention. During these Holy Days we have the extra challenge to find the time to give glory to God. May you discover ways to allow your worship of God to become a highlight activity this week!
