Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

I am sure you have heard the idea that what helps us appreciate the beauty of music is the silence between the notes. Note upon note without pause becomes simply noise and the absence of notes is only silence. Many of our Church disciplines similarly focus our attention on the blessings we enjoy by encouraging us to pause from them on occasion. Abstaining from meat on Fridays, setting aside time for solitude and silence while on retreat, and sacrificing a favorite food or activity during Lent are examples.

This comes to mind for me because we at St. George are attempting to nurture an appreciation of the events of the Church Year by modeling our *Lifelong* Faith Formation efforts on the Church Year, rather than the standard academic year. At this point in the academic model, students in grades K-8 would have been in Faith Formation classes for about a month. Several students have, in fact, mentioned to me that they miss the classes. (Pause a moment and consider that sentence again—young people are *missing* Religion class!)

We have two major objectives with this *Church Year* approach to faith formation:

- To emphasize that **learning and practicing our Roman Catholic faith is a lifelong process**. Everyone in the parish is part of faith formation and encouraged to attend any or all of the Faith Fests scheduled from Advent through Pentecost!
- To recognize that **all the tenets of the new Diocesan Faith Formation curriculum are presented each time we attend Mass**. Liturgy, Scripture, the Creed, Prayer, and Community life are components of every Mass.

Worshipping God as a community of faith is the fundamental learning experience of our faith.
